In 2026, year to date, we have had more than 150 volunteers at the farm and 100 visitors whose lives have been touched by pediatric cancer. By season's end we will have given away thousands of pounds of food, thousands of flower stems, and a gazillion smiles with a side of glorious hope.

In January 2026, Embrace Compassion became a licensed agency training adults with developmental and intellectual disabilities in pre-employment skill building. We have served 20 adults this year and celebrated our first person placed in a real job. Our learners volunteer right alongside everyone else — and that partnership helps Embrace Compassion shine.
